## This funding will be used to

- Using trends from Year 2 reading data, predict and increase the percentage of students in Year 3 meeting the National Minimum Standard from 90% to 98% in reading.
- Using trends from Year 2 reading data, predict and increase the percentage of students in Year 3 that will perform in the Upper 2 Bands of reading.
- Improve the percentage of students in PREP reading PM level 9 or above.
- Develop a learning plan for students who are predicted to be at or below the National Minimum Standard.
- Improve teacher capability through focused coaching and professional development to improve student performance.

### Our strategy will be to

- Focus on oral language as a key foundation for the development of literacy skills and a strong indicator of later reading, writing and overall academic achievement (Bradfield, 2013)
- Build teacher capability in explicit teaching and consolidations through coaching (Communications Trust, 2013)
- Track student performance on a 5-weekly cycle (Hattie, 2012)
